

Colby Cemetery

The Colby Cemetery is a quarter of an acre site in the northeast part of town, on early deed maps in Lot 3, Range 2. It is located down a leaf cover lane on the west side of Dodge Hill Road just south of the Bound Tree Road. Below it is the Mill Pond. There are many unmarked graves. Several bodies were removed and re-interred in the public cemeteries in the village. Nicholas Colby, the first sexton of the cemetery, who died March 30, 1836, is one of the oldest memorials. The oldest is of Stephen Adams, who died in 1811. He was in the Revolutionary War. The most recent is of John Frazier, age 81 who died on December 9, 1860.
