

Plummer Cemetery

The Plummer Cemetery is a one acre plot in the southeast part of town that was laid out during the Revolutionary War for the use of nearby residents. It is located on 568 River Road. On the early deed maps it is on Lot 2 Range 10. The oldest inscription is that of Persis Gibson Brown who died on March 13, 1790. Persis was the mother of the first child to be born in Henniker. Many granite markers in this cemetery are uninscribed. One old grave in the cemetery is that of Simeon Rogers who died September 12, 1812. His stone reports that he was a cousin of George Washington. The cemetery is closed for burials except for those with family plots.
